Tree Talk: *When planting a new tree on your property, it is really important to think about the size of the tree in 10-20 years or how it might affect a neighbor's property. It's a good idea to let a neighbor know about planting a tree right at the fence line that might shade the neighbor's vegetable garden. Roots can also be an issue if the tree is planted too close to a house.*
